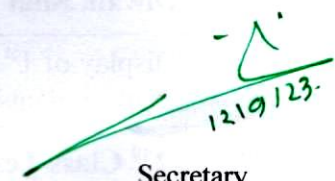

1. If the proposed date of certain activity happens to be a holiday, next working date shall be taken as date of activity.
2. Mentor for admitted students:
Each faculty deputed as mentor for 15-20 students at the time of their admission shall be in continuous association with the students for their proper guidance in academics, training, placement etc.
3. Communicate the attendance status of each month to students and parents i.e., attendance if less than 75%.
4. Medical leave as per Medical Performa only.

 - Extra Classes for weaker students to reduce dropout rate and to improve pass percentage.
 - Women's Grievance Redressal & Counselling Cell.
7. Additional activities for Polytechnics:
 - Aadhar Card enrolment for all students and faculty
 - Institute level cultural and sports meet (As per Institute/State Calendar)
 - State level sports meet
 - To facilitate the students to get their passport issued
 - NSS Club, Startup Club, Student's club, IT Club.
